He rose to be secretary to the India Company,
which office he discharged with great credit till
his death, on 2 June, 1818. He wrote the comic
operas of The Humourist; Love in the East; The
Haunted Tower; The Siege of Belgrade; and
several lesser pieces, which were very successful.
