The above table will I hope supply the information Lord Mahon wishes for. I have to express my regret that I did not answer your letter by return of the post. I had delayed the enquiry till 2 o'clock and I was then

unexpectedly and unavoidably obliged to  
go out. I hope the delay will not have  
been very inconvenient to you.

You are quite right in your conjecture  
about Vicentini and Mörzger. Of the *Geographische  
Romanen* the  
first vol. by Vicentini, was published in 1817 in 4<sup>to</sup>  
the 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> by Mörzger in 1821 and after.

(the above contain the text only)

The plates ~~of~~ in Folio (to which alone I had referred)  
have on the title plate the name of Vicentini and  
the date of 1817. Vicentini's text however describes  
the first 14 of the plates only. Perhaps the safest  
way would be to quote the work as by Vicentini and  
Mörzger. There is a Bastard Title to the first  
vol. of Mörzger, as Vol 2 of the Geographische  
Romanen

I am much obliged by your information  
respecting the Conqueror's wastes I thought his  
incursions had extended into Craven. Our habitat  
for a short time will be near Sheffield where

not very much of Antiquarian interest is  
to be expected. I shall perhaps also visit  
Dulby but only for a day or two.

W. Holmes and myself are sorry to hear such  
an indifferent account of Lady Ellis' health  
may present our very best respects, and

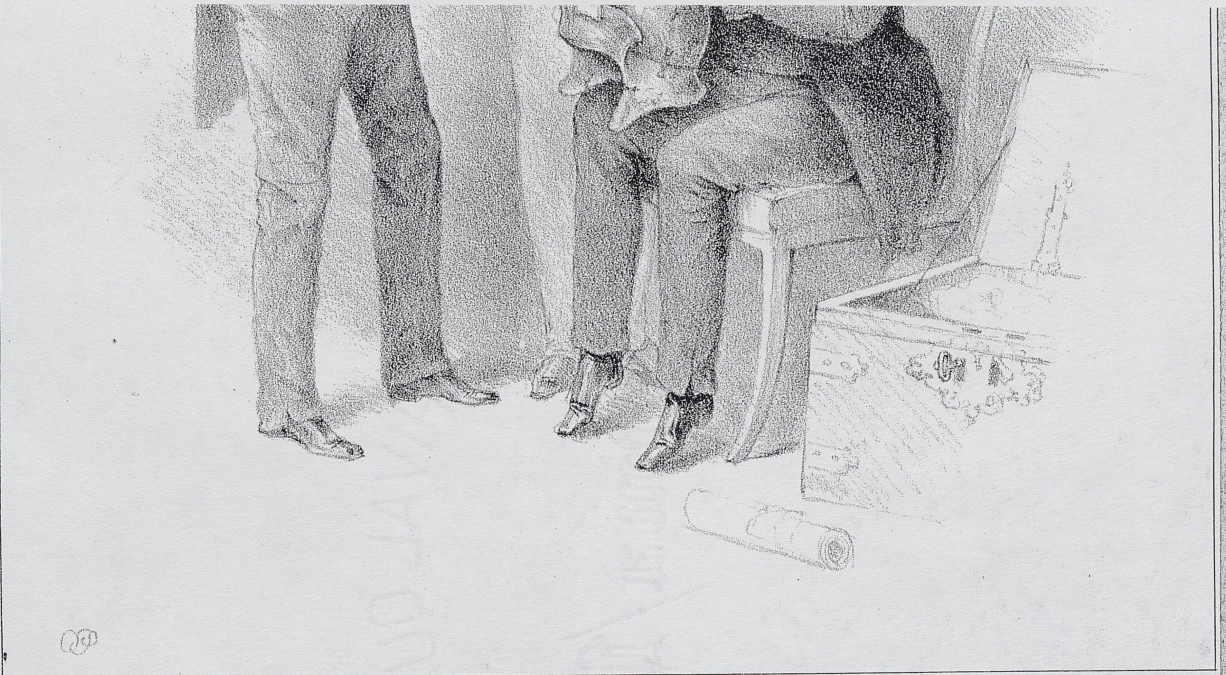
