by him lent unto His Majesty for His Majesties
Service, upon the Account of the late War, the
~~Tenth~~^{Tenth} Day of May 1667 - upon
the Credit of the Act for Eleven Moneths Tax,
granted to His Majesty by a late Act of Parlia-
ment, as appears by the Book of Registry in the
Receipt of His Majesties Exchequer, appointed
to be kept by the same Act. And these, toge-
ther with his or his Assignes Acquittance, shall be
your Discharge herein.
