April 12, 1898.

The faculty met in adjourned session in the President's room, in the College building, at 3 pm.

All present except Prof Shockleford and Capt Swigert

Object of the meeting.—consideration of report of committee from the Engineering faculties.

On motion ordered that the Board of Trustees be requested to extend the courses in Engineering to five years.

Prof. Miller moved that the resolution to adopt the first recommendation of the special committee from the Eng. faculties be approved, Seconded.

Prof. Anderson moved to amend by the provision that the Freshman, Sophomore, and Junior ~~years~~ shall remain as at present, that the present Senior class be designated ~~as~~ Sub-Senior and that the fifth be known as the Senior year, Seconded.

Amendment was accepted, put, and carried. The original motion as amended was then carried.

On motion ordered that Elementary Physics be moved from the Academy and taught here after in the College

Prof. Wernicke submitted a revised schedule of studies for the several Scientific Courses, as a result of the deliberations of a committee appointed for that purpose by the Scientific Faculty.

The Secretary read a resolution recently adopted by the Executive Committee requesting the Board of Trustees to discontinue, for the present, the College Mess, as now organized.

Voted on motion of Prof. Wernicke that the faculty concur in the proposed change of plan or system.

The faculty then adjourned to meet on April 19<sup>th</sup> at 3pm to consider further the revised schedule submitted by Prof. Wernicke.
