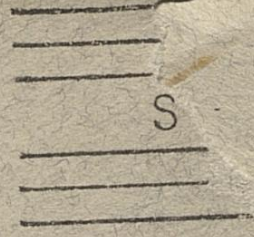

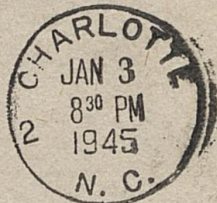
Dear La Vonne,
