Dear Sir

In one of your letters to J. Quirkall, without date, you wrote "I have just been offered by one Cabelliff, a boundary of 5500 acres, situated about thirty miles up the Tug fork of Sandy, coming out to the river, and about ten miles above the Burning Spring. This land is held in option until the 1st of March, when \$3000 must be paid, which extends the time three months longer, then the balance of money to be paid. This tract can be purchased for six dollars per acre and a good title given."

I am instructed to get further information from you in reference to this property, and also another mentioned in the same letter. You say - "this land is held in option till the 1st of March, when \$3000 must be paid." Do you hold this option? If so, does it mean that you have until the 1st of March next, to decide whether or not you will take the 5500 acres
