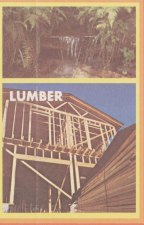
**FOREST ENVIRONMENT**

The Chattahoochee National Forest offers endless possibilities to those who love fishing, hunting, taking scenic photographs, and the study and enjoyment of nature.

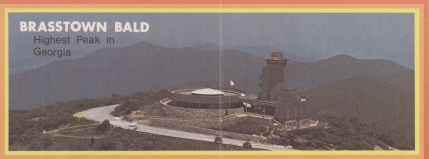

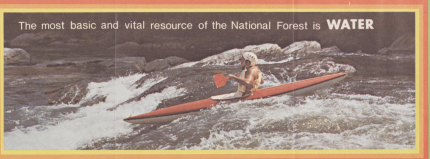
