The Faculty convened in regular monthly session. The following gentlemen were noted as absent:- Messrs. Shackelford, Bennett, Kastle, Reville, Pryor.

This being a regular meeting the minutes of the last regular meeting and of several called meetings were read, and, with a few corrections, were approved. The corrections were made at the proper places and the amended minutes went upon record.

Col. Clay requested that three days, Wed., Thurs., Frid. - May 16-18, - be set aside for him for extra drilling of the cadet corps; granted.

Dr. Kastle moved that the resolutions upon the deaths recently occurred among the Faculty and College Officers, be made matter of record; carried. (Some of these resolutions were never placed in the hands of the Sec.)

Upon motion of Mr. Miller an adjourned meeting for Frid., May 18, 9 a.m., was ordered, "to consider the matter of holding June examinations in different portions of the State, for the purpose of entitling students to entrance in the Fall." Upon motion of Dr. Kastle the following were appointed a committee to consider and report upon this matter:- Messrs. Miller, Nelson, Kastle, White.

Upon motion of Mr. Nelson it was resolved that no resolution or motion, except routine motions should be voted upon, hereafter, until reduced to writing and placed in the hands of the Sec.
