On motion of Prof. Haste that College exercises be suspended on Jan 5, as a mark of respect to Captain Swigert and of the high esteem in which Mrs Swigert was held.

On motion of Prof Patterson ordered that the faculty go in a body with the remains to the depot.

On motion ordered that a select number of students act as pall bearers and that the battalion march to the depot.

On motion of Prof Mathews ordered that a committee of four members go with the remains to Frankfurt, that Prof Shockford be one of them and that he appoint three others,
Mr Peter, Prof Patterson and Prof White appointed

On motion of Prof Anderson ordered that Prof. Mathews be requested to prepare a suitable floral design and send it to Capt. Swigert.

On motion of Prof Blanton ordered
that a Committee be appointed to prepare
appropriate resolutions of respect
to the memory of Mrs Swigert.

Chairman appointed Profs Blanton, Matthews, and
Anderson.
