

A. and M. College of Kentucky.
February 8, 1901

The faculty met in regular monthly session in the President's room in the College building at 3:30 pm.

Present, President Patterson, Professors White, W. K. Patterson, Kastle, Roark, Mathews, Miller, Ponce, Mackenzie, Brooks, Carpenter, Anderson,

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read, corrected, and modified by the addition of notes, after which they were approved.

The Secretary of the Scientific Faculty submitted the following:

"Growing out of a discussion which seemed to reveal a general dissatisfaction with our present marking system, it was resolved, upon motion of Prof. Miller, that the general faculty be requested to appoint a committee to take the whole matter of student marking under consideration with a view to devising a system, which, if approved by the Faculty, shall be presented to the Board of Trustees with the recommendation that it be substituted for the system now in use.

As revealed by the remarks leading up to the adoption of this resolution, some of the features or points that would be appropriate for this committee to consider would be:

1. The relative merits of the quinquesimal and centesimal systems.
2. The "grouping system" versus the "individual ranking system"
3. System of penalizing for absences and tardiness: Adoption of some uniform rules for.
4. Frequency of submitting reports: At end of month or term? "

Ordered on motion of Prof. Roark that the foregoing recommendation be recorded and that a committee of three be appointed to consider it and report thereon.

On motion of Prof. Peuce ordered that a special committee be appointed, to consider how to compel the prompt return of students after vacations and holidays, and to report thereon.

Ordered on motion of Prof. White that when the faculty adjourns, it adjourn to meet on Friday, February 22nd at 3:30 pm.

Ordered on motion of Prof. Peuce that a committee of three of which Prof. Neville shall be chairman be appointed to prepare the annual Catalogue

The Secretary of the committee on accredited or affiliated schools read the report of the committee relative to revising the standards of admission with other modifications.

Ordered on motion of Prof. Roark that all that part of the report which deals with the matter referred to the committee shall be printed and distributed among the members of the faculty for consideration.

Ordered on motion of Prof Miller that the College give two medals; one in English and one in Latin, for the student passing the best examination in these subjects at the next Blue Grass Tournament to be held at Lancaster, Kentucky, and that a scholarship be given to the student receiving the greatest number of medals exclusive of athletics and music.

On motion of Professor Matthews the last page of the report of the Committee on affiliated schools was ordered to be printed for the consideration of the faculty.
