Commencing at the N.W. corner of the Isaac Thomas Survey; Thence South to the south line of Twenty Third Street; Thence East to the West line of Avenue 1; Thence South to the center line of Twentieth Street; Thence East to the East line of Isaac Thomas Survey; Thence North to the West line of said Isaac Thomas Survey; Thence North, westerly along said Right of Way to the South line of the A. Anderson Survey; Thence West to the S.W. corner of same; Thence North to the northeast corner of the M. Gray Survey; Thence West to the North West corner of the D.W. Campbell Survey; Thence South to the North West corner of the A.T. Card Survey; Thence East to the North East corner of the same; Thence South to the place of commencing.

Know all men by these presents, that M.C. Ellis of the County of Tarrant and State of Texas do hereby adopt the foregoing map correctly representing my division of a portion of the Isaac Thomas, M.C. Ellis, W.M. Gray, L. Cohen, Thicks and A. Vogt surveys; and I do hereby dedicate to the use of the Public all Streets and Alleys represented hereon Reserving the exclusive right to grant to any individual or Corporation the right and privilege of using the Streets of this Addition for the purpose of erecting and maintaining Telegraph and Telephone lines with the use of poles overhead or by placing wires underground; Also to grant to any individual or Corporation the right and privilege of using the Streets of this Addition for the purpose of constructing and maintaining lines of Surface or Cable cars to be operated by Steam, Electricity or Water Power.
