Know all men by these presents that I Andrew Barnett  
of Fauquier County, State of Virginia, have made  
or caused, constituted and appointed and by these  
presents do ordain, constitute and appoint my son James  
Barnett of Madison County, Virginia, my true and  
lawful attorney, for me and in my name, but to  
my use, to ask, demand sue for, recover and receive  
all and every species of property to me belonging in  
the state of Kentucky, as one now due, and owing to me  
by any person or persons, whatsoever, but more especial-  
ly two tracts of three tracts of land entered in my  
name lying in said State of Kentucky and for  
the non payment of the same rents and arrears of  
rents or any part thereof to sue for and recover for me  
and for me and in my name to give acquittances  
and discharges for the same, make sale of said land  
and any other property and the money received  
by him immediately thereupon to pay over to me, or  
any representatives, or to my order and further to do  
and execute all and every other lawful act and acts  
needful for recovering, receiving, and obtaining of my  
property now due or to grow due, for the premises or any  
part thereof, but to my use as aforesaid, as fully and  
effectually to all intents and purposes as if I was  
personally present, fully ratifying and confirming  
whatsomever my said attorney shall lawfully do, or  
cause to be done, in or about the premises. In witness
