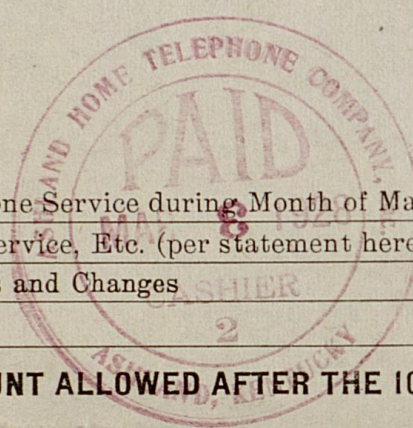

Dear Sir:

You will shortly receive a call for Meeting of Stockholders of Norton Iron Works, the purpose of which will be to ratify the sale of all of the Norton Iron Works' property to this company, who now own 92% of its capital stock. The price to be paid is not to exceed the Norton Company's book value. It is evident that this company cannot be run, except at a loss, and it is our purpose to liquidate it.

I enclose herein a copy of their last financial statement which, since charging off the Ashland Steel property, shows a book value of \$24.85 per share.

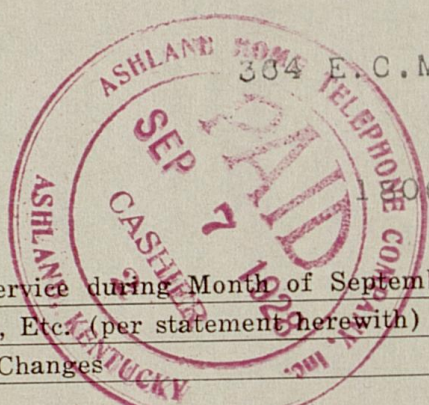


