It is now my honorable duty to report to you an account of my stewardship as your State Secretary during the fiscal year that is now drawing to a close. Since my function is that of a record keeper and administrator, my message is borne to you in figures, not in words. The highest consideration I can wish, therefore, is that you read well the cold, but refreshing facts thus brought you, and draw from them such conclusions as will make for wise and judicious procedure in planning and directing the future course of our great institution.

The work of the present year has of necessity been unusually heavy. New record books have been opened in all departments, making necessary the copying of our entire membership from the old books; new forms of quarterly report blanks have been introduced in the Relief Department; a few articles of modern office equipment and many minor office sundries have been installed; two hundred and twenty death claims, many of which were involved in disputes and lawsuits have been adjusted and paid. Further, the collection of the Special Assessment has offered a heavy and sometimes knotty problem, while the amount of correspondence arising from these extraordinary conditions has been enormous.

However, through unswerving perseverance, even at a great personal sacrifice, and with the intelligent and kindly co-operation of the whole official staff, and certain past grand officers, and with the support of the membership throughout the state, we have not allowed the work to suffer greatly in any department.

I want to thank you for the great responsibility you have reposed in me, for the support you have given, and for the honor you have conferred on me. Be assured that I have endeavored to do my full duty competently, courteously, kindly, fearlessly.
