



This Indenture made this 6<sup>th</sup> day  
of February one thousand seven hundred and Ninety  
six Between Richard Gates and Barbara his wife  
of the one part and Robert Todd of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said Richard Gates for  
and in Consideration of the sum of Twenty  
eight pounds to him paid by the said Robert  
Todd have aliened and sold and by these presents  
doth confirm to the said Robert Todd his heirs &  
Assigns for ever a tract of Land in the County of  
Clarke lying on the Kentucky River near the mouth  
of Boones Creek and bounded as follows Beginning  
at a cedar on the cliff thence with Talberts line North  
sixty two degrees East one hundred and fourteen poles  
to a white Oak and Hickory thence North forty five  
degrees West one hundred and thirty six poles to two  
Ash trees and a Hickory thence North twenty de-  
grees East forty two poles to a blue Ash thence  
South Eighty East one hundred and thirty five poles  
to two blue Ash trees and Sugartree thence South  
Ninety poles to a hawberry and Sugartree on the

River Bank thence down the same South Seventy  
four degrees West One hundred and sixty poles to  
two Beeches and huckleberry thence North Seventy  
four degrees West twenty one poles to the Beginning  
containing one hundred acres be the same more or  
less To have and to hold the Lands herein  
conveyed with all its appurtenances to the said  
Robert Todd his heirs and assigns for ever

And the said Richard Yates and Barbara his  
wife All and singular the premises hereby sold  
to the said Robert Todd against themselves  
their heirs and all other persons whatsoever  
doth and will warrant and forever defend In  
witness whereof the said Richard Yates and  
Barbara his wife have hereunto set their  
hands and seals the day and year above written
