*fourth day of September one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty two*

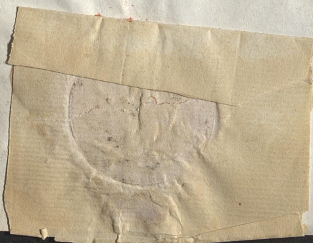
there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto *Robert Todd* of the County of *Greenup*

a certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing *Two Hundred acres* by Survey bearing date the *twenty third day*  
*of May one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty five* lying and being in the County of *Greenup*, on the  
Waters of *Blackman's Creek*, and bounded as followeth *South Beginning* at an ash, *hogwood and hickory*  
corner to *Thomas Page's* pre-emption running thence with his line and the Course thereof *South seven*  
*teen degrees West three hundred and Eighty poles* to two buckeyes corner to *John Todd's* pre-emption  
thence *South Seventy three degrees East eighty two poles* to two spanish Oaks on the *South West side*  
of *Turners* river corner of *Wallace Covert's* pre-emption thence with the line of said pre-emption *North*  
*eighteen degrees East three hundred and Sixty four poles* to three elms and a hograss in the line of a survey  
of *Seven hundred and Sixty* acres made for the said *Robert Todd* thence with said line *North Sixty*  
*three degrees West eighty six poles* to the Beginning

with its Appurtenances; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of Land with its Appurtenances, to
