

CHE draft plan among UK news in recent months

It has been anything but the best of times for UK since the spring of '85.

In late June, UK faced what President Otis A. Singletary termed "the most serious assault on the University in modern history and maybe since its existence." He was referring to the first draft of the Council on Higher Education's "Strategic Plan for Higher Education" which called for — among other things — closing UK's College of Dentistry and transferring control of the Jefferson Community College from UK to the University of Louisville.

At its June 24 meeting, the Board of Trustees passed a resolution opposing the draft. Stated the resolution: "Any such proposals to dismantle the University of Kentucky are unacceptable to the board and will be vigorously opposed."

CHE officials contended the draft was a working paper and not a final document.

Earlier this month, the council released its most recent draft which recommends for the community colleges either consolidating the vocational schools as technical institutes under the community college system or establishing a separate governing board for both.

As for the dental school, the draft recommends: convening a panel of experts to decide which school to close, closing either UK's or U of L's dental school and restricting enrollment in the remaining program, keeping both schools but reducing enrollment and funding or discontinuing both and contracting for dental education with out-of-state schools.

Burns E. Mercer, CHE chairman, said the draft outlines different options to get public opinion. Meetings were held across the state to gather public reaction to the draft earlier this month.

About 700 people attended the Council's first public hearing, which was held in the main auditorium of the Fine Arts Building.

About 25 people — faculty members and members of the community — spoke before council officials on subjects ranging from the closing of the dental school and law school to promoting UK as a nationally renowned, comprehensive University.

Singletary reiterated his opposition to closing the dental school and the changing of the community college system. He also congratulated the CHE for dropping the Jefferson Community College out of the proposal and urged the council to make UK the comprehensive university in the state.

Most of the speakers spoke out against the plan, and several Fayette County legislators urged the council to let the general assembly make the final decision on the closing of any educational facility in the state.

Earlier in the summer came the transfer of a \$4.3 million energy contract from UK to the University of Louisville. The contract went to fund coal research projects at the Kentucky Center for Energy Research Laboratory.

Speaking before the Joint Interim Energy Committee, State Energy Secretary George Evans, who made the decision to transfer the contract, cited 23 of 25 projects behind schedule and a reluctance to change in the direction of research on the University's part as reasons for the transfer.

Evans also said UK does too much theoretical and not enough applied research, made "unnecessary and disruptive personnel action which . . . lowered morale and created anxiety and apprehension among the employees" of the lab, used the lab "to promote University interests to the detriment of the state's interests" and that UK felt it "owned" the lab.

In a later meeting of the committee, Singletary and Lyle Sendlein, director of the Institute of Mining and Minerals Research and former director of the lab, denied Evans' charges.

An ad hoc committee of the Board of Trustees was formed to review the contract loss. Committee members said they hope to identify any shortcomings or mistakes on the part of UK personnel and advise University officials of ways in which contracts of research administration can be improved in the future.

The ad hoc committee heard from Evans and various University officials and will present its findings to the board at its Sept. 17 meeting.

In separate meetings in late June, the UK and U of L boards of trustees presented recommendations against a merger between the two institutions.

The merger recommendations were prepared by special committees of the boards at the request of the CHE to study the feasibility of merging the universities.

Jack Dulworth, who was the student member of CHE, said the recommendations effectively put an end to further merger talk by the Council.

Both the UK and U of L recommendations cited political difficulties; faculty, student and staff opposition; and other perceived disadvantages as reasons to oppose the merger.

The sentencing of Elzie Alexander Morton was delayed last month by legal questions about the sentencing power of judges.

Morton, 32, of 1972 Kingtree Drive, was scheduled to be sentenced July 19 for the murder, rape and sodomy last summer of UK graduate student Lin-jung Chen, but Fayette Circuit Court judge Armand Angeleuci delayed, asking instead for memoranda briefs from the prosecuting and defense attorneys.

Angeleuci said the briefs "won't" help him decide whether the jury's recommendation was binding.

He told the attorneys to submit their simultaneous briefs on Sept. 3 and set a sentencing hearing for Sept. 20.

The prosecution in the case asked for the death penalty for Morton, but the jury recommended 20-year sentences for the rape and sodomy convictions and life imprisonment without parole for at least 25 years for the murder.

The proposed "sexual orientation" amendment to the University's student code, which spent the better part of last year working its way up the bureaucratic juggernaut, was voted down by the Board of Trustees at its May 7 meeting.

The 16-2 vote against the amendment ended a five-month effort by a coalition of student groups to add "sexual orientation" to a list of criteria in the student code against which the University cannot discriminate.

The proposal was written to protect homosexual students from discrimination in admissions and financial aid.

An advisory committee of students and administrators, in addition to the Student Government Association, endorsed the amendment.

A trustees' committee also announced that UK will sell its holdings in Boeing Co. because of the company's human rights policies in its South African operations.

Bruce Lansford, who was acting chairman of the board's investment committee at the time of the decision, said the University will instruct its investing agents not to put money in companies that do not follow the Sullivan Principles in South Africa.

Centralized add-drop to be held Tuesday

Registrar recommends students bring pencils and patience to rework schedules

Before you leave for add-drop Tuesday don't forget a No. 2 pencil, and when you find the queues in front of Memorial Coliseum stretching to the curb, pick up a little patience.

That's the advice of University Registrar Randall Dahl, who says the last item will "go a long way to making it (add-drop) an acceptable event."

He also advises students to arrive at the time their name is scheduled or later, but not before.

A class schedule book and one's class schedule card are also important things to bring along.

The first students — with last names beginning Mc-O — will start through centralized add-drop at 10 a.m. Tuesday in the Coliseum, and the building will remain open until 5:30 p.m.

Although there are lines and the atmosphere on the main floor can seem hectic, Dahl said the experi-

ence "shouldn't be terribly traumatic." Students will get an instruction sheet when they enter.

If you just want to drop a course you can avoid the Coliseum and do it through the office of the department that offers the course.

If you miss add-drop Tuesday, the College of Arts & Sciences will be in the Coliseum Wednesday, and other colleges will have tables at their individual deans' offices. After Wednesday, A&S departments will conduct business at their offices.

Students can continue to add courses until Sept. 4, which is also the last day to withdraw from the University or reduce course load and receive 50 percent refund.

The last day to drop a course without it appearing on the transcript is Sept. 18, and students can drop a course and receive a W — withdrawal — until Oct. 21.

Dahl cautions students not to accept "street wisdom" when amending their schedules. "We do find sometimes people take academic advising from their friends who may

Tuesday also is the last day to drop a course or cancel registration and get a full refund.

Aug. 28-Sept. 4 will be late registration for students who didn't advance register or were admitted late.

Sept. 11 will be the last day to pay fees to avoid cancellation of registration and/or meal card.

Campus buses can aid in getting to class on time

Going to class could mean a long hike across campus, but the Lexington Transit Authority and UK help students get to class on time by providing them with free transportation on campus.

Beginning Wednesday, six LexTran buses — three for north campus and three for south campus —

will run every weekday school is in session. South-campus buses run from Commonwealth Stadium to Columbia Avenue and north-campus buses run from Greg Page Apartments to Memorial Coliseum.

The north route begins at 7 a.m. and runs until about 6:15 p.m. The buses run at intervals of about 15 minutes.

The south route will run between 6:30 a.m. and 5:35 p.m. at intervals of six to eight minutes.

Currently, a proposal is being considered to expand the UK campus area buses travel. But until a settlement is reached, students must pay 50 cents to use the city buses to get off campus.

LexTran provides pamphlets with route and schedule information. They can be obtained at the following campus locations: Student Center information desk, the main entrance of the Peterson Service Building, the lobby of Patterson Office Tower, the main entrance to the Medical Center and the Dean of Students office, 513 Office Tower.

Free movies will be shown at 7:30 Monday and Tuesday night at the Worsham Theater (located in the Student Center) as part of "Wildcat Welcome Week." The featured movies will be the James Bond hits "For Your Eyes Only" and "Live and Let Die."

Anyone interested in seeing the UK campus from a unique perspective should plan to take a ride aboard "Old Blue" Monday at 11 a.m., noon or 1 p.m. The tours begin at the Visitor Center in the Student Center.

Throughout this week, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., information on various student organizations will be available at booths set up along the Student Center patio. Student representatives will be there to answer any questions interested students might have concerning the organizations.

Paul Hayden, SAB president, said

this week of activities is for new and returning students alike.

September and October will be highlighted by Homecoming, guest speakers and concerts, among other activities.

On Sept. 12, the concert committee will present a concert featuring Squeeze with special guest stars The Who and The Truth. Tickets for the concert, which will be held in Memorial Coliseum, go on sale Monday at the Student Center ticket office. The costs are \$8 for upper arena and \$10 for floor and lower arena.

On Sept. 15, the second annual "Fall Free For All" sponsored by SAB, Student Government Association, Collegians for Academic Excellence and WKQQ-FM will take place at Still Field. From 11 a.m. to 6 p.m., local merchants will give away free merchandise and coupons. Hayden said they hope to have 25 area businesses participate.

Katie Tech, concert committee co-chairwoman, said the committee is working with WKQQ-FM to include some concerts by local bands in the day's activities.

Although Homecoming isn't officially until Sept. 28, when the Cats take on Cincinnati, the week preceding the big game will be full of activities for everyone. Voting for the homecoming queen candidates will begin on Tuesday, Sept. 24. The annual fashion show featuring all the candidates will be that evening.

On the 26th, Wildcat Roar will take place, but will have a somewhat different format than it has in years past. Rather than being held at the E.S. Goodbarn, the pep rally will be at Commonwealth Stadium. At the conclusion of the roar, a 15-20 minute laser show will be presented. This year's Homecoming theme is "Up, Up and Away."

On Oct. 7 and 8, SAB and Rolling Stone magazine will sponsor "The Rolling Stone Expo" which will bring representatives from several corporations affiliated with the music and fashion industries to campus. At the conclusion of the second day of the expo, the concert committee will present a concert featuring Lone Justice, a new "American roots rock" group from Los Angeles in the Student Center Ballroom. Tickets will be \$6.50 for students and \$8 for the public.

Al McGuire, NBC color commentator and former head basketball coach at Marquette University, will be the guest speaker for Contemporary Affairs on Oct. 15.

"The Rock & Roll Time Tunnel," a multi-media presentation put together by Kodak, will be shown at noon, 4, 7 and 8 p.m., Oct. 24 in the Student Center Ballroom. This program, which incorporates music, slides and videos will be free.

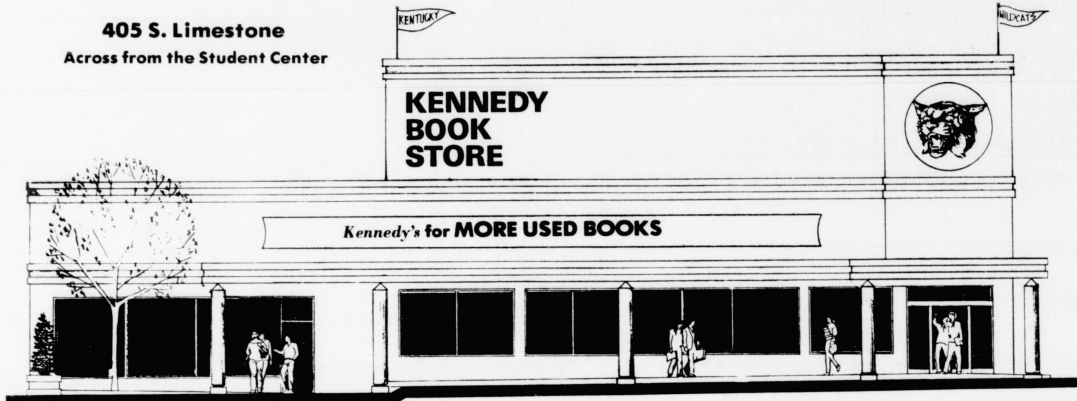

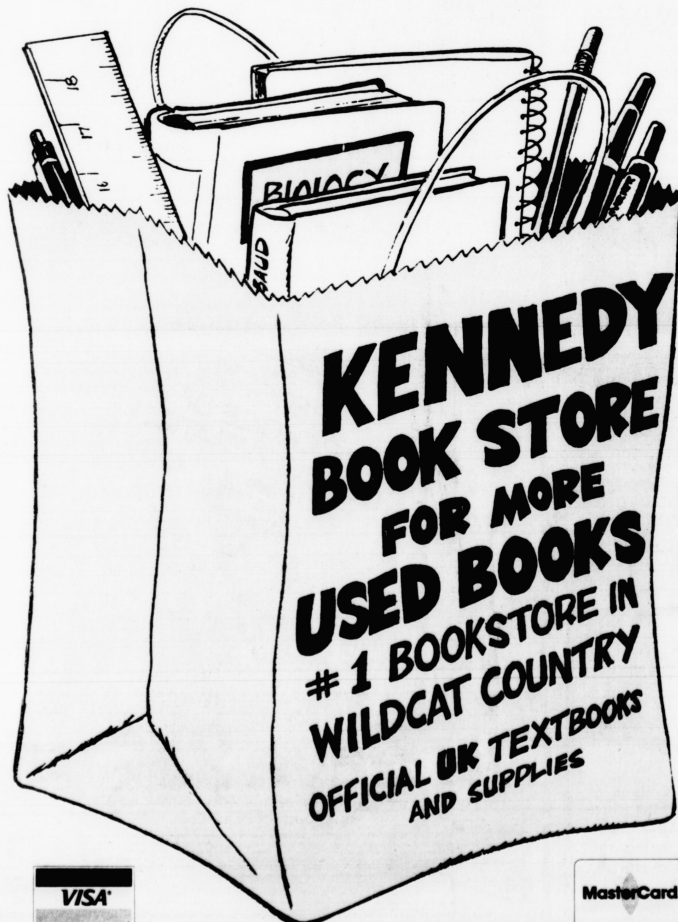

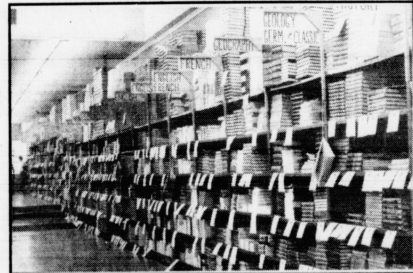
