Change of Title:

Architectural Engineering 8 from Theory of Architectural Design to Theory of Architecture.

Change of Content:

Architectural Engineering 4a - Architectural Design. (3 sem. hrs.)
Principles of aesthetic design and functional planning of buildings, grade "C" Beaux Arts Institute of Design. Drawing room, nine hours.
Prerequisite: Junior Classification and Arch. Eng. 1.

Architectural Engineering 4b - Architectural Design. (3 sem. hrs.)
Continuation of Arch. Eng. 4a. Grade "C" Beaux Arts Institute of Design. Drawing room, nine hours. Prerequisite: Junior Classification and Arch. Eng. 4a.

New Courses:

Architectural Engineering 6a - Advanced Architectural Design. (4 sem. hrs.) A study of more advanced problems in architectural composition. Grade "B" Beaux Arts Institute of Design. Drawing room, twelve hours. Prerequisite: Senior Classification and Arch. Eng. 4b.

Architectural Engineering 6b - Advanced Architectural Design. (4 sem. hrs.) A continuation of Arch. Eng. 6a. Grade "B" Beaux Arts Institute of Design. Drawing room, twelve hours. Prerequisite: Senior Classification and Arch. Eng. 6a.

Fire Protection and Safety Engineering 101a - Fire Protection Engineering. (2 sem. hrs.) I Sem. 1949-50; Repeat I Sem. 1951-52. A series of lectures and recitations on building materials, types of construction, fire resistance and combustibility ratings, analysis of fire hazards, treatment of special hazards, preventative and protection methods including water supply, fire fighting equipment, special extinguishing devices; and rate making including methods of measuring fire hazards, town grading, inspection methods and preparation of maps and reports. Lecture and recitation, 2 hours a week. Prerequisite: Junior Classification.

Fire Protection and Safety Engineering 101b - Fire Protection Engineering. (2 sem. hrs.) II Sem., 1949-50; Repeat II Sem. 1951-52. Continuation of Fire Prot. and Safety Eng. 101a. Lecture and recitation, 2 hours a week. Prerequisite: Junior Classification.

Fire Protection and Safety Engineering 101c - Fire Protection Engineering (2 sem. hrs.) I Sem. 1950-51; Repeat I Sem. 1952-53. Continuation of Fire Prot. and Safety Eng. 101b. Lecture and recitation, 2 hours a week. Prerequisite: Junior Classification.

Fire Protection and Safety Engineering 102 - Safety Engineering. (2 sem. hrs.) II Sem., 1950-51; Repeat II Sem. 1952-53. A study of safety methods including industrial accident prevention, accident data, statistics and their value, industrial safety hazards and protective equipment, plant safety programs and accident analysis, transportation and general safety. Lecture and recitation, 2 hours a week. Prerequisite: Junior Classification.

Drop the following course:

Architectural Engineering 6 - Independent Problems. (4 sem. hrs.)

Dean Stahr presented recommendations from the College of Law as follows:

Changes of names of courses:

Law 172 a-h, Problems of Research, be changed to Law 172 a-h, Legal Research and Writing.

Law 142, Industrial Relations, be changed to Law 142, Workmen's Compensation.

Law 170, Legal Ethics, be changed to Law 170, The Legal Profession.

Changes in requirements for the degree of LL.B.:

1. The number of semester hours in Law required for the LL.B. degree be changed from 80 to 82.

2. All courses presently listed as required courses be no longer listed as required courses.

All above changes to be effective September 1, 1949.

Recording of grades of colored student:

The credits and grades in Law earned during 1948-49 by John W. Hatch, Jr., under the tutelage of the faculty of the College of Law be recorded by the Registrar, in the event said student enrolls for further study in the University.

The Faculty approved the recommendations of the College of Law.

Dean Pardue presented the following recommendation from the Graduate Faculty, which was approved by the University Faculty:

That students of Kentucky State College, who have satisfactorily completed graduate courses taken under the contract entered into on July 13, 1948, between the State Board of Education of Kentucky and the Board of Trustees of the University of Kentucky, be allowed to transfer the corresponding credit to the University of Kentucky partially to satisfy degree requirements: provided, the students are admitted to the Graduate School of the latter institution and were academically eligible for admission to it when the courses were begun.

The Faculty adjourned.
