Dear Sir - Yours of the 13th inst
dated at Grenada is rec^d and noted. In the closing
remarks you ask me to give you my views & that

I am instructed by Mr Whitehead to say
that he will take ~~the~~ what the face of the note calls for
to wit 4,565 ²²/₁₀₀ provided you or Mr Graves, will pay
it in two equal payments - the 1st to be paid in
April, or May next and the other in 12 months there
after, to be secured by deed of trust - or Mortgage
on unincumbered real estate - these are my instru-
ctions and for the present - are the only terms upon
which I could compromise - and hope that they
may prove satisfactory - if they should not please let
me know soon what is the best you or Mr Graves,
