

It is agreed between R. R. Sharkey and
R. O. Edwards as follows:-

Edwards has this day sold to
R. R. Sharkey the Ravenwood plantation
in Pointe Coupee Parish La and agrees to
convey the same to said Sharkey in con-
sideration of said Sharkey, delivering up
or accepting against the same, the original, having been destroyed,
to him his obligations given said Sharkey for
Sharkey's portion of the purchase money and
releasing the Mortgage given to secure the
payment thereof - the portion of the
purchase money (say \$100,000) due M. J.
Waters having been paid him by said
Edwards - And said Sharkey is further
to release the lot on which the Confederate
Army stood in Jackson Miss from the
incumbrance thereon held by Coleman
Britton & Waters of New Orleans -
